

Printing Prehospital Care Reports (PCRs):

1. Choose the number of PCRs to be printed

Print a single PCR:

Click on the record to be printed using a single left mouse click. If the Service Date is within the last three days, the Run Details panel will open. Click the print icon in the top left corner of the Run Details pane.

Note: if the Service Date is older than three days, the Run Details will no longer be available and the user will be asked to authenticate their user credentials to generate a PDF of the completed PCR. Continue to step 2.
